



Timer save in the shower C-0629

This digital timer can operate in two ways:

- 1) as a stopwatch to measure time.
- 2) minus the time set to zero, at which sounds an audible alarm. On the back is a suction cup that lets you set the timer to any smooth surface.

It is an educational product for children and adults, as you learn how to save water and energy use in the shower and therefore save money

Open the battery cover by turning it with the help of a coin. Remove the protective plastic from the battery to activate the apparatus. Immediately the numbers appear on the LCD

Stopwatch (count up)

- 1. Press the (ST / SP) to set the stopwatch to count upwards. Maximum count: 99 minutes and 59 seconds.
- 2. Press again (ST / SP) to stop the stopwatch.

Timer (countdown)

- 1. Beats on the (S) will advance the number of seconds until the desired selection. You can also press and hold the button (S) and the second advance.
- 2. Click in the button (M) will advance the number of minutes until the desired selection. You can also press and hold the button (M) and the minutes advance.
- 3. Press (ST / SP) to start timing.
- 4. When the countdown reaches zero the alarm will sound. Press to stop, otherwise sound for 30 seconds. To stop the alarm, the display retains the last set time reference. Press (ST / SP) to start a new countdown timer with the time before.

Press and hold the button (M), while pressing the (S) and the display is set to zero.

Battery

Replace the battery when the alarm sound and display are not clear.

Insert the battery according polarity. Never pull the old battery in the trash, put it in a green dot or container for recycling batteries.

Attention

Do not immerse in water timer.

Avoid getting water to the shower head on the timer.

Each year you can save water 12m³, 90m³ the gas and 170kg of CO₂
